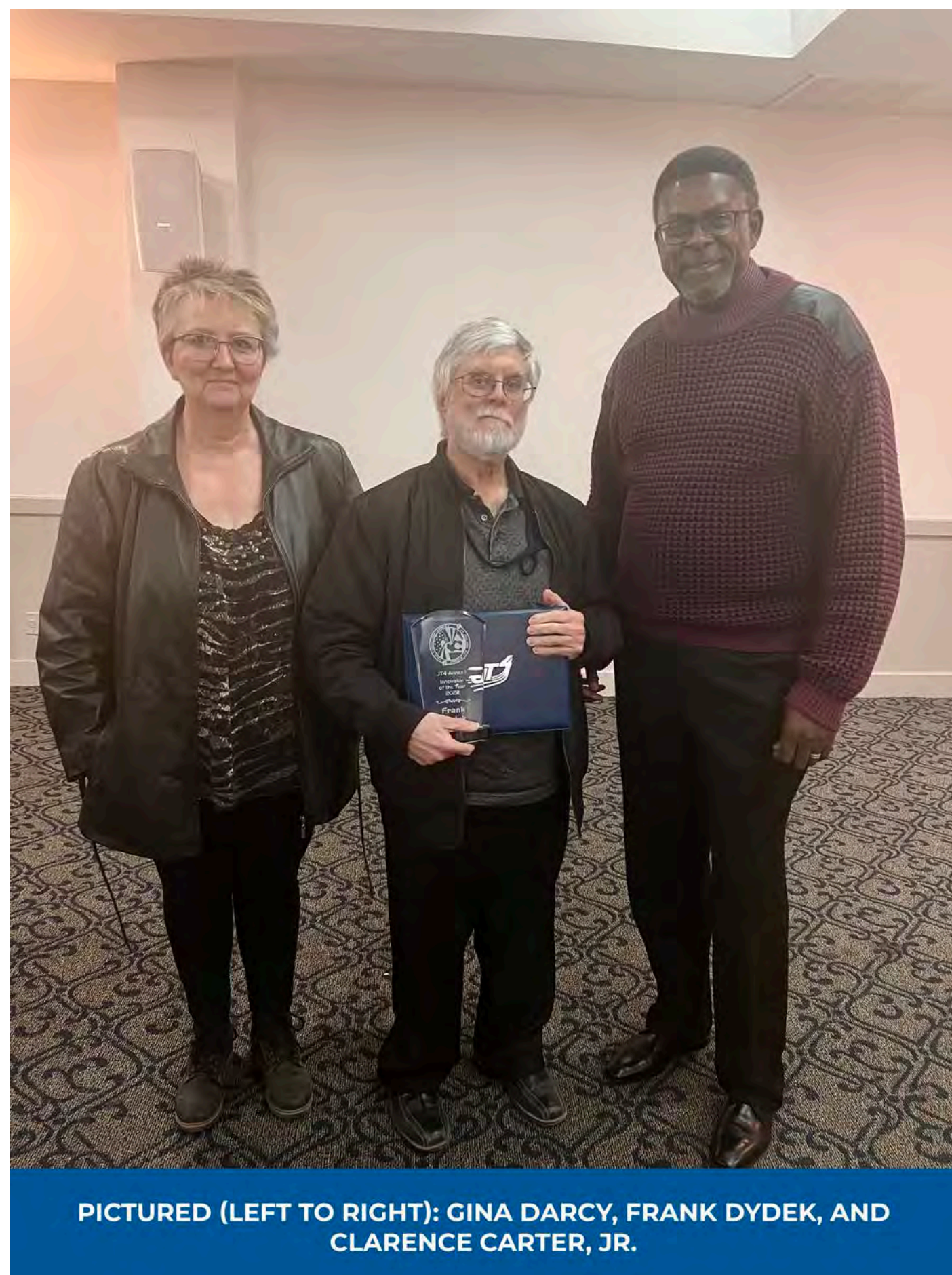

SUBJECT: Contract Award Announcement

It gives me great pleasure to announce that IntegrITS Corporation (IntegrITS) was awarded a \$14,918,694 cost-plus-fixed-fee, firm-fixed-price, indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity contract to provide operation and maintenance support for the MOBILE AT-SEA SENSOR SYSTEM (MATSS) HULL, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL (HM&E) PROGRAM. MATSS is a manned ocean-going towed vessel used by the Pacific Missile Range Facility (PMRF) to provide over-the-horizon data collection and range safety operations from remote locations in the Pacific Ocean. This contract includes options which, if exercised, would bring the cumulative value of this contract to \$18,755,728. Work will be performed at the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam in Hawaii and if all options are exercised, work will continue through September 2025.

I would like to extend a special thanks to Steve Fox, Steve Browning, and Harry Beatty. These three have established IntegrITS as a preferred partner on MATSS due to their stellar performance and customer relationships spanning over three decades. This history and reputation played a critical role in our selection for this award.
