They also work with women who are victims of human trafficking.

A key focus of LoveBridge's ministry is mentoring women who are living in recovery homes or safe homes and are reintegrating into society. They have supported hundreds of women through this difficult transition. So many have transformed their lives and are seeing their dreams come true--not only for themselves, but for their families as well.

From extreme poverty to human rights atrocities to refugee resettlement, there are so many crises facing our international community. IntegrITS has supported many non-profit organizations working around the world. Here are three examples of our financial giving across the world--two of which are especially timely, as they are currently serving Ukrainians fleeing war.

**Romanian-American Missions (RAM)** supports a network of churches in Romania and Moldova that are housing and feeding Ukrainian refugees as they arrive in their countries.



**UnBound** is an anti-human trafficking organization that traveled to the Ukraine/Poland border to train local law enforcement on recognizing human traffickers and educating refugees on how to travel safely.

**Free Wheelchair Mission** has distributed over 1.2 million wheelchairs to 94 different countries. They are providing a crucial resource to men and women with disabilities around the world. The World Health Organization estimates that 75 million people are in need of a wheelchair.
