


Welcome to *The IntegrITS Weekly Digest*!



This week, we're taking a trip to the desert to highlight our **Green Flag Fort Irwin** (**GFFI**) team.

Fort Irwin is home of the National Training Center. According to the <u>US Army</u>, "Fort Irwin provides realistic joint and combined arms training focused on developing soldiers, leaders, and units of America's Army for success on the 21st century battlefield." Spanning over 1,000 square miles, it is the largest US Army base by land area.

The National Training Center has a truly robust approach to training our armed forces. Our GFFI team specifically supports air-land integration combat training exercises.



A couple other noteworthy aspects of the National Training Center are the Opposing Forces (OPFOR) and mockup "villages." As their name implies, OPFOR is a brigade representing the "enemy" in training exercises. Fort Irwin also has twelve mockup "villages" that prepare soldiers for deployment. These villages are replicas of foreign towns, all the way down to actors speaking the local language/dialects while roleplaying civilians, government officials, insurgents, etc.

Our team supports the United States Air Force and the United States Army in the execution of joint training exercises. We operate and maintain eight P5 (air combat training) tracking sites, four ground-to-air radio sites, and various networks/ display systems.

Our team is proud to successfully support ten training exercises each year. We work through a number of challenges day-to-day to ensure effective training for the Warfighter.

What is something you wish the whole company knew about your team?

Our team possesses a variety of skills including networking, tower climbing, equipment maintenance, equipment operation, vehicle maintenance, safety, security, and more. This diverse set of skills, partnered with the trust and camaraderie in our shop, allows us to be successful. Everyone really seems to enjoy working with one another.

Tell us about any developments on the horizon in your team's area of work. This can include exciting future projects, industry-wide developments you anticipate, challenges for which you will need to adapt or innovate.

The equipment and capabilities in our work center are constantly evolving. We are looking forward to a Link16 installation later this year, which will improve overall safety and situational awareness for the entire 2508 Training Complex. The 2508 Training Complex includes the airspace and associated land used by:

- Naval Air Weapons Station China Lake
- National Training Center, Fort Irwin
- Air Force Test Center, Edwards Air Force Base

We are also anticipating an electronic warfare (EW) upgrade which will allow us to integrate various threats into our display and debriefing systems. We're looking forward to a P5 tracking upgrade which should also take place later this year.
